1. The Panel approved the minutes from the previous meeting of 5th December 2006.
2. Modification 14 – Aligning DCC10 with Grid Code WFPS1
Doireann Barry made a presentation on the proposed modification. After a discussion the modification was approved as amended in the attached document.
Action: DSO to forward modification proposal to CER for approval.
3. Modification 15 – Maximum 38kV and MV line voltages
Ronan O'Hogartaigh and Kevin outlined the proposed modification. The modification was discussed and approved by the panel.
Action: DSO to forward modification proposal to CER for approval.
4. Modification 16 – Interface arrangements at 38kV embedded generation sites
Ronan O'Hogartaigh outlined a proposed modification in outline form only. The proposal in brief is that there will be a DSO owned and operated 38KV circuit breaker cubicle at the boundary point with 38kV tailed and teed embedded generation. The principle of the modification was approved. It was agreed that DSO will from now on issue connection offers on this basis.
Action: DSO to draft required revisions to Conditions Governing Connection at 38kV and MV document to reflect this change and present at the next Code Panel meeting.
5. CER consultation on micro-generation
Keelin O'Brien and Paul Hogan outlined the responses received by CER on their recent consultation. CER expect to issue their decision on this issue in the coming weeks.
