Entry Details

- Real Nation is the promoter of the Stay Safe, Stay Clear with ESB Networks Competition and all correspondence should be addressed to the promoter at: **Stay Safe, Stay Clear with ESB Networks, c/o Real Nation, 94 Baggot Street Lower, Dublin 2, D02 XN82**
- All individuals working on a project must be registered pupils in a Primary or Special Needs School, and between the ages of 4 and 13 (4 to 18 in Special Needs Schools). We welcome entries from Special Needs Schools and judges will take into consideration that these are Special Needs Schools Entries.
- All work entered must be pupils' own but may be aided/guided by a class teacher.
- Each entry must be accompanied by an entry form.
- It is the responsibility of all participating schools to give permission for their pupils to participate in the programme and oversee their participation herein. A teacher/principal must sign each individual's entry form to validate permission for all participants.
- Real Nation and all connecting parties are not liable in any way for costs, expenses, damages, liability or injury arising out of or in any way connected with the competition. Submissions from groups of individuals will not be accepted. This competition must be undertaken by individuals only.
- Submission of an entry will be taken to mean acceptance of these terms and conditions.
- Real Nation does not commit to notifying unsuccessful entrants of the competition or to returning unsuccessful entries.
- Poster entries should be no larger than A3. Entries larger than this will not be accepted.
- The closing date for entries is Friday 21st November 2025
- All winning entries, school winners and teachers will be announced in December 2025.

 - A prize fund of €3,500 which will be shared with regional and national winners
 - All teachers who submit an entry from their pupils will be entered into a draw to win a €250 One 4 All Voucher
 - ESB Networks may feature the winning posters as part of our Spring safety campaign
